SUGGESTIONS FOR MAKING THE MOST OF YOUR LEADERSHIP SUMMIT SPONSORSHIP

Engage with the event and attendees beyond your tabletop:



Cocktail receptions: Network, Network, Network! Enjoy food, drinks, and the chance to meet attendees in a casual, fun setting. Ask them questions about what they are looking to get from the event and why they are attending.
